Concessions:

Ms. Jordan discussed the new concession stand and had a drawing for everyone to look at. It is a 12 X 24 ft. stand and we can get it for around \$4000.00. She went to the Middle School and looked at the one they have there. Mr. Pinkston will order it and it will be in 10 days so she needs suggestions as to what needs to change. Mr. DeLucas said there may be matching funds at the beginning of the year with the new administration so we will wait until then before purchasing. She talked to him about maybe getting them to run a water line over since Joyce Bullock is putting in a new building across the field. She has someone that will remove the old building and

help strip the counters out. Mr. Poupard said that he had mailed out 120 letters to business for our letter writing campaign. We have \$280 already.

Fundraiser:

The candle sales will start now and needs to be back by Dec 5th.

Mrs. Jane Beasley said that there were tshirts and hats still available. She also said that no one has come forward to take over her job. She has the job description. She also needs to buy some more bow ties.

New Business:

Luann Cox said that we got \$435 from the blankets and flags that was sold at the game. A motion was made and seconded to put this money in the Savings Account. The motion passed.

Mr. Poupard made the suggestion that we take 5% of the fundraiser money to put into the saving account for the building fund. A discussion followed with a motion being made to take 5% of the concession stand money made each year and put it in the savings account, labeled as building fund. It was seconded and passed.

Mr. Poupard said that he had been approached by Bobby Hieart- He has a big sound system and said he would be willing to do a dance each month for a fundraiser. A discussion followed with the idea of maybe having a Valentine's dance if we can get it approved through Mr. DeLucas and find a place to have it. It was tabled for a later discussion.

Mr. Johnson will do the programs for the band concert and Evelyn Poupard will get the names to him of the supporters. He also needs money to have them printed. A motion was made and seconded to do this. It passed. Luann Cox will check into how much it will cost here in Williston and let Mr. Johnson know.

A suggestion to look into how much an ice machine will cost. Cathy Jordan and Eric Chaffee will get prices and bring them to the next meeting.
